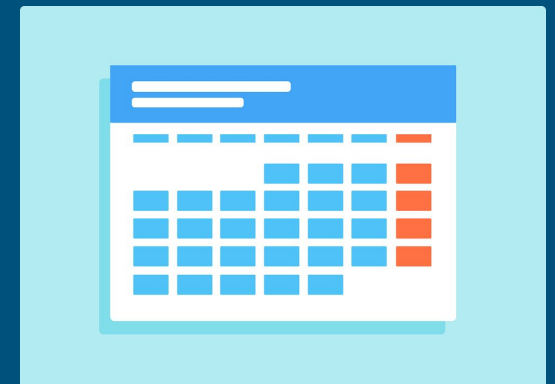

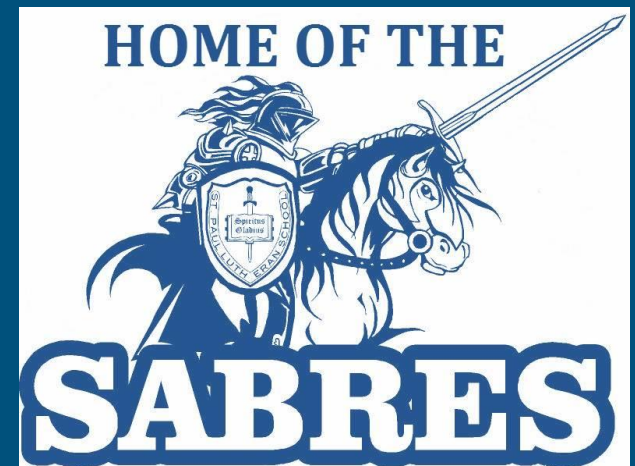
TADS Billing Updates
